- Email address PC, tablet or smartphone with Internet access
- Your session will expire after 30 days. After 30 days, continue to use for free by regenerating complimentary access

The New User window will appear. Enter your Email address, preferred Password, First and Last name. Then click Create my account and you'll be logged in. Now browse and enjoy!




To access & edit your account settings, click on the **nickname** word at the top right of the page

Email address & Password created at step 3




If you see these messages...

Using PressReader is <u>completely free of charge</u> for library members, however the provider of the service uses the same platform for its commercial subscribers as it does for library members. Consequently you might sometimes see messages about <u>Pay for access</u> or <u>Complimentary access time left</u>. Here's how to deal with these...

Regenerating Complimentary access time available

Follow steps 1-3 above to regenerate the time period shown and your access, if required.



Removing pay for access messages:
